
LETTER DATED 6 APRIL 1990 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following Namibia's accession to independence on 21 March 1990 and in keeping with the constructive consultations we had in Windhoek on a number of urgent matters, including in particular Namibia's membership in the United Nations, I would like, by this letter, to submit an application, in accordance with Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations.

Convinced of the acceptance of the application, the Republic of Namibia undertakes to make a solemn pledge to accept and carry out the obligations contained in the present Charter.

In this context, the Government of the Republic of Namibia would be most grateful if Your Excellency could ensure that the application is given consideration on a priority basis, so as to enable the Namibian delegation to participate in the work of the special session of the General Assembly devoted to economic development, to be held from 23 to 28 April 1990.
