LETTER DATED 26 APRIL 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that on 7 April 1990, an Iraqi boat violating the terms of cease-fire entered the restricted zone at 73200-72000 on the map of Khorramshahr for reconnaissance purposes. The Iraqi boat was spotted by Iranian forces and it did not retreat until warning shots were fired.

Such Iraqi violations of cease-fire are extremely provocative with possible serious consequences for which only the Iraqi side is to be held responsible.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
