Committee on Disarmament

The General Assembly,

Recalling paragraph 120 of the Final Document 1/ of the first special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament,

Having considered the report of the Committee on Disarmament 2/,

Stressing once again that considerable and urgent work remains to be accomplished by the Committee on Disarmament,

Noting that the Committee on Disarmament adopted its Rules of Procedure, which contain detailed arrangements on all aspects relating to its work,

Noting also that rule 17 of the Rules of Procedure of the Committee on Disarmament, as contained in appendix I to its report, states that "the Secretary-General of the United Nations will be requested to provide the staff as well as the necessary assistance and services needed by the Committee and any subsidiary bodies which it may establish".
