IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE
DENUCLEARIZATION OF AFRICA

Nigeria: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Deeply alarmed at the report that South Africa might have detonated a nuclear explosive device in September 1979,

Recalling its decision on this matter taken at its forty-seventh meeting on 26 October 1979,

Taking note of the report of the Secretary-General in document A/34/674,

1. Expresses its appreciation to the Secretary-General for the action taken by him in pursuance of its decision of 26 October 1979;
2. Appeals to all Member States in a position to do so, to provide all relevant information at their disposal to the Secretary-General;
3. Requests the Secretary-General to follow the situation closely, and in the light of further relevant information to be submitted by Member States;
4. Further requests the Secretary-General with the assistance of appropriate experts to prepare a comprehensive report on South Africa's plan and capability in the nuclear field, and to submit the report to the General Assembly at its thirty-fifth session.
