Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.2/34/L.31

Corrigendum

1. As it is now clear that some of the assumptions made in document A/C.2/34/L.58 concerning the estimated costs to be incurred for the conclusion of preparations for the Third General Conference of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization are invalid, there is need for a revision of these estimates and for a correction to document A/C.2/34/L.58 as follows:

Paragraph 4

Paragraph 4 should be replaced by the following:

It is now proposed that an interregional preparatory meeting for the Third General Conference of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization be held from 17 to 21 December 1979. It is also proposed that a regional meeting at the ministerial level be held on 13 and 14 December 1979 in preparation for the Third General Conference of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization. The additional costs, for which no provision has teen made under section 12 (United Nations Industrial Development Organization) of the 1978-1979 budget have been estimated on the basis of the following assumptions:

- (a) That while the normal venue of the meetings would have been Vienna, the General Assembly will authorize the Secretary-General to convene the two meetings in a Latin American country;
- (b) That the languages of the meetings will be Arabic, English, French and Spanish:

- (c) That the interregional preparatory meeting will be composed of a plenary, a negotiating group and a drafting group, and will hold three meetings in the morning and three meetings in the afternoon;
- (d) That, while the precise format of the ministerial level meeting is still to be determined, between two and four meetings daily will be held both in the morning and afternoon.

Paragraph 5

Paragraph 5 should be replaced by the following:

5. On the basis of the foregoing, the expenditure with respect to the holding of the interregional preparatory meeting and the ministerial level meeting is estimated as follows:
