United Nations Children's Fund

The General Assembly,

Taking note of Economic and Social Council resolution 1979/53 of
2 August 1979,

Having considered the report of the Executive Board of the United Nations
Children's Fund on its session held at Mexico City from 21 May to 1 June 1979, 1/

Having in mind its resolution 34/4 of 18 October 1979 on the International
Year of the Child and in particular paragraphs 6, 7, 8 and 12 thereof,

1. Commends the policies and activities of the United Nations Children's
Fund;

2. Endorses Economic and Social Council resolution 1979/53;

3. Fully appreciates the enlarged responsibilities placed upon the United
Nations Children's Fund in light of the still enormous unmet needs of children in
developing countries and the importance of maintaining and enhancing the new
impetus to activities on their behalf generated by the International Year of the
Child;

Expresses its appreciation to all Governments that are contributing to the Fund and appeals to all Governments that have not done so to increase their contributions to the Fund in relation to their capacity, so that it may reach the revenue target of \$290 million for 1981, as projected at the session of the Executive Board. 2/
