Costa Rica and Uganda: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Recalling that one of the purposes of the United Nations under Article 1 of the Charter is to promote and encourage respect for the human rights and fundamental freedoms embodied in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Bearing in mind resolution 33/105 of 16 December 1978, in which the Commission on Human Rights is requested to take into account, in continuing its work on the over-all analysis, the views expressed on the various proposals during the general debate on the item at the thirty-second and thirty-third sessions of the General Assembly, including a post of United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights,

Considering that the Working Group was nevertheless unable, in its consideration of the over-all analysis, to make a thorough evaluation of the proposal to create a post of United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.

Decides to consider at its thirty-fifth regular session the question of the creation of a post of United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.
