The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 3520 (XXX) of 15 December 1975, in which it decided to convene a world conference in 1980, and 33/189 of 29 January 1979 in which, it emphasized the subtheme "Employment, Health and Education" for the programme of action for the second half of the United Nations Decade for Women: Equality, Development and Peace,

Recalling also its resolution 33/185 of 29 January 1979, Preparations for the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women: Equality, Development and Peace, including the adoption of the subtheme "Employment, Health and Education",

Taking note with interest and appreciation of the reports by the Preparatory Committee for the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women: Equality, Development and Peace and also the provisional agenda for the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women in the 95th Plenary meeting 29 January 1979,

1. Decides to include in the provisional agenda of the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women: Equality, Development and Peace, an item on the Palestinian women entitled: "Effects of Israeli occupation on Palestinian women inside and outside the Occupied Territories.

- A - Review of the social and economic needs of the Palestinian women.
- B - Special measures for assistance to Palestinian women inside and outside occupied territories".
