INTERNATIONAL ACTION TO COMBAT DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING

Letter dated 29 May 1990 from the Permanent Representative of Argentina to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to document A/45/262, entitled "International action to combat drug abuse and illicit trafficking", which contains the text of the Declaration of the World Ministerial Summit to Reduce the Demand for Drugs and to Combat the Cocaine Threat, held at London from 9 to 11 April 1990.

In that connection, on instructions from my Government I wish to draw your attention to the fact that:

- (a) The "Falkland Islands" are listed in section B of the appendix to the Declaration, entitled "The United Kingdom Dependent Territories and Crown Dependencies";
 - (b) The territories in question are the Malvinas Islands;
- (c) The Malvinas Islands are the subject of a sovereignty dispute between the Argentine Republic and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
