## ROUTINE SAFEGUARDS INSPECTION IN IRAQ

At the request of the Iraqi authorities, the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is publishing the following statement on a recent safeguards inspection in Iraq:

"Routine safeguards inspections of Iraq's nuclear facilities were carried out in early April 1990. The Department of Safeguards sent the Resident Representative of Iraq to IAEA detailed statements of conclusions on 2 May 1990. In these statements, based upon the data collected between March 1989 and April 1990, the conclusion was reached that all material under safeguards has been accounted for."
