INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the present submission is to report on the performance of the United Nations programme budget for the biennium 1978-1979 and to reassess in the light of available information the amounts voted by the General Assembly at its thirty-third session (resolution 33/205) following the first performance report and various resolutions with financial implications.

The present report is essentially financial. It will be supplemented in due course by a report on programme implementation, in accordance with resolution 33/118, in which the General Assembly approved the recommendations contained in the report of the Joint Inspection Unit (A/33/226) and reflected in the conclusions of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (CPC) (A/33/38) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ) (A/33/226/Add.2 and Corr.1). The next report on programme implementation will be submitted to CPC at its twentieth session and to the General Assembly at its thirty-fifth session.

The revalued amount to be assessed on Member States which results from the most recent expenditure and income estimates shows a decrease of \$1,063,700, or 1 per cent, compared with the amount voted by the General Assembly at its thirty-third session.

This decrease is explained by a downward revision of both expenditure and income:

A detailed analysis of the adjustments is presented later in the report. As regards expenditure, the analysis is by section, subsection and programme; as in all budget documents, there is an apportionment by main object of expenditure at the programme level. A detailed analysis of income sections is also provided.

In explaining expenditure adjustments, systematic account has been taken of the following determining factors: inflation, rates of exchange, decisions of policy-making organs, and other changes.

In over-all terms, inflation, rates of exchange and the decisions of policy-making organs contribute to an increase in expenditure; the reduction in total

expenditure requirements is attributable to other changes, for which the decrease more than offsets the impact of the factors responsible for increases:

Annex I contains a summary of the impact of the determining factors by section and subsection. Annex II provides a breakdown of revised estimates by section and subsection and by main object of expenditure.

As regards rates of exchange, in 1979 there was again a depreciation of the dollar in relation to the Swiss franc, the Austrian schilling, the Netherlands florin and the Kenyan shilling, as indicated in table 1.

Inflation gave rise to increases in post adjustment that generally exceeded the provisions made (see table 2). The upward revisions for operating costs and supplies are largely attributable to substantial price increases in energy, communications, and various products.

The decisions of policy-making organs give rise to relatively small requirements; details are given in the analysis of each section. A summary list appears in annex III.

Among the other changes consolidated under the last of the determining factors, the most important component is the vacancy rate, which is often referred to in the section-by-section analysis, and which is partly responsible for the downward revision of salaries and staff assessment.

Annex III

Analysis of additional requirements attributed to decisions of policy-making organs

(ii) Commitments entered into under the authority granted by General Assembly resolution 32/21⁴, paragraph 1 (a), in connexion with the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Namibia, the United Nations First and Second Survey Missions to Namibia and the Proximity Talks on Namibia, pursuant to Security Council resolutions 431 (1978) and 435 (1978), and the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Lebanon, pursuant to Security Council resolution 436 (1978) (\$803,100).
7. Additional requirements called for by the ESCAP Committee on Agricultural Development and the Commission (\$18,800).
14. The transfer to the United Nations Fund for Drug Abuse Control (UNFDAC) Secretariat to Vienna (\$23,600).
18. Commitments entered into under the authority granted by General Assembly resolution 32/21⁴ for purposes arising from ECOSOC resolutions 1979/32, 33, 34 and 35 (\$213,100).
19. Commitments entered into under General Assembly resolution 32/21⁴, paragraph 1 (b), in connexion with the retirement of four judges in 1979 and the appointment of an ad hoc judge (\$93,800).

21. Expenses relating to the Committee to Review Public Information Policies and Activities and its ad hoc working group (\$5,000).
 22. Additional requirements of the International Civil Service Commission in connexion with certain surveys and studies (\$46,100).
 23. Additional requirements due to various unforeseen meetings added to the calendar of conferences during 1979 at Headquarters and Geneva resulting to increased conference serving requirements (\$1,840,600).
2. The total additional requirement of \$3,098,000 listed under paragraph 1 was offset by certain decreases under various sections amounting to \$710,900, resulting in a net additional requirement of \$2,387,100 attributable to decisions of policy-making organs.
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
