Feasibility of establishing a single Administrative Tribunal

Canada and Japan: revised draft decision

The General Assembly decides:

(a) to request the Secretary-General and his colleagues on the Administrative Committee for Co-ordination to pursue a progressive harmonization and further development of the statutes, rules and practices of the Administrative Tribunal of the United Nations, with a view to strengthening the common system and aiming at the establishment of a single tribunal; and

(b) to request the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session.
