LETTER DATED 20 JULY 1990 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that at 0430 hours (local time) of 23 June 1990, Iraqi forces shot an Iranian sold: at the N.T.P. 509-439 on the map of Khosrow Abad. Mohammad Reza Vahidi, the Iranian soldier, was martyred at 0650 hours of the same day. The UNIIMOG personnel in the region came to the scene and visited the corpse of the martyr and confirmed the incident.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
