NOTE VERBALE DATED 7 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SAINT KITTS AND NEVIS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of St. Kitts and Nevis to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and has the honour to submit the following statement from the Right Honourable Dr. Kennedy A. Simmonds, Prime Minister of St. Kitts and Nevis.

"The Government of St. Kitts and Nevis has received with deep concern reports of the invasion of Kuwait by Iraqi Military Forces.

The Government of St. Kitts and Nevis condemns this act of aggression against a small state, and considers it a flagrant violation of the Charter of the United Nations. We are convinced that this dastardly act can have grave implications for international peace and security, and for the development of small states, and that it further emphasizes the vulnerability of small states.

We call for immediate and unconditional withdrawal of all invading troops from the territory of Kuwait, and call on the Government of Iraq to settle its differences with Kuwait by peaceful means and in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations."

The Permanent Mission of St. Kitts and Nevis to the United Nations has the honour to request that this document be circulated as a document of the United Nations Security Council.
