NOTE VERBALE DATED 16 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF
ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Israel to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and acknowledges the receipt of his communication SCPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990, referring to resolution 661 (1990) which was adopted by the Security Council at its 2933rd meeting, on 6 August 1990, in connection with the item entitled "The situation between Iraq and Kuwait".

The Permanent Mission of Israel to the United Nations, upon instruction of the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of Israel, Mr. David Levy, has the honour to inform the Secretary-General of the United Nations that Israel does not export or import any commodities or products to and from Iraq and Kuwait, nor does Israel serve as a transit State for commodities or products destined for Iraq and Kuwait or originating therefrom. Similarly, no assets or deposits of Iraqi or Kuwaiti origin are held in Israel.
