Note verbale dated 10 August 1990 from the Permanent Mission of Solomon Islands to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Solomon Islands to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to submit the following statement from the Honourable Minister for Foreign Affairs and Trade Relations of Solomon Islands, Sir Baddeley Devesi, in respect of the situation between Iraq and Kuwait:

"In the light of the non-compliance by Iraq on the earlier call of resolution 660 (1990), adopted by the Security Council on 2 August 1990, and mindful of the noble aims, duties and responsibilities of Member States under the Charter, the Government of Solomon Islands, with deep concern for peace and security in the world, hereby reaffirms its commitment, acceptance and obligations as contained in resolution 661 (1990) adopted by the Security Council at its 2933rd meeting in August 1990."

The Permanent Mission of Solomon Islands hereby requests that the above statement be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly, under item 35 of the provisional agenda, and of the Security Council.
