LETTER DATED 30 JULY 1990 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETAPY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to Your Excellency's attention three major recent violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces.

- 1. Recently, Iraqi forces began causing disorder in Iranian communications around the cease-fire area. On 3 May 1990, Iraqi forces deployed a mobile radar at the GCs of 065-967 on the map of Nowsud interrupting Iranian communications in the region for three hours on the same night.
- 2. On 20 June 1990, at 1920 hours, three Iraqi helicopters were observed flying from the south towards Kani Sheik in a low altitude, and landing at the GCs of NC 610-280 on the map of Kani Sheik. They flew back to south at 1945 hours.
- 3. On 25 June 1990, in the early morning, Iraqi forces penetrated the Iranian territory to the GCs of NE 98000-69000 on the map of Sumar, firing two RPG-7 at the group stationed in the site in Baneh causing the martyrdom of three Iranian soldiers and injuring another.

It will be highly appreciated if this letter is circulated as a document of the Security Council.
