LETTER DATED 20 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF OMAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to your note No. SCPC/7/90 (1) dated 8 August 1990 addressed to the Minister of State for Foreign Affairs of Oman, I have the honour to convey to Your Excellency the views of the Government of the Sultanate of Oman regarding resolution 661 (1990), which was adopted by the Security Council at its 2933rd meeting on 6 August 1990, in connection with the item entitled "The situation between Iraq and Kuwait":

The Government of the Sultanate of Oman fully and unreservedly endorses Security Council resolution 661 (1990) and has taken appropriate measures to ensure that the resolution is implemented. It should be noted that the level of commercial, economic and financial exchanges between Oman and Iraq was already very low.
