Communiqué issued on 5 August 1990 by the Military Committee of  
National Recovery (CMRN) of the Republic of Guinea

In a communiqué issued on 5 August 1990, the CMRN and the Government of the Republic, expressing their disapproval of any resort to the use of force against and any violation of the sovereignty of a State which is a member of the Organization of the Islamic Conference and of the United Nations, condemned Iraq's military intervention in Kuwait. The CMRN and the Government deplored and expressed their acute concern over the loss of human life in Kuwait on 1 August 1990. They appealed to the Islamic and international communities with a view to stopping any further escalation of violence and restoring peace in the region.
