NOTE VERBALE DATED 22 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic to the United Nations has the honour, with reference to the Secretary-General's note SCPC/7/90(1) dated 8 August 1990, to inform him of the measures taken by the Government of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic regarding the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990).

The Czech and Slovak Federal Republic, in accordance with the provisions of United Nations Security Council resolution 661 (1990), following the decision of its Government, fully joined the economic embargo imposed upon Iraq. Exports of all goods to Iraq and Kuwait and imports of all commodities and products from these countries have been suspended. All international economic activities connected with export and import of these countries have been halted. The customs clearance of all commodities determined for Iraq and Kuwait as well as the commodities originated from these countries have been prohibited in such way that these goods would not pass the border of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic. At the same time, measures were taken to prohibit the transfer of all funds and payments to Iraq and Kuwait.

The Permanent Representative of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic would greatly appreciate if this communication could be issued as a document of the Security Council.
