NOTE VERBALE DATED 24 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF
BURUNDI TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Burundi to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note SCPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990), has the honour to convey to him the reply of the Government of the Republic of Burundi as received by telex today, namely that the Government of the Republic of Burundi is applying the sanctions against Iraq as adopted by the Security Council on 6 August 1990 in its resolution 661 (1990).

The Government of Burundi states that no product of any kind whatsoever is today imported from Iraq or Kuwait or exported to those countries. Moreover, the Government of Burundi has suspended all transactions with occupied Kuwait until further notice.
