NOTE VERBALE DATED 31 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BAHAMAS TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, and has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's note SCPC/7/90/1 of 8 August 1990, and has the honour to inform him of the actions taken by the Government of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas with a view to implementing Security Council resolution 661 (1990) of 6 August 1990.

On 10 August 1990, the Government of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas endorsed resolution 661 (1990) and began to apply the sanctions required by same.

In accordance with paragraphs 6 and 7 of the resolution, the Government of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas took the following steps:

1. Suspended all trading links with Iraq and the Iraqi backed government of Kuwait;
2. Undertook to prevent as far as possible the trans-shipment of all commodities of their exports by Bahamian individuals and by Bahamian flagged vessels;
3. On 10 August the Central Bank of The Bahamas took action to freeze the assets of Iraq and the Iraqi backed government of Kuwait.

The Government of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas does not recognize the act of annexation and supports the sovereignty and integrity of the legitimate Government of Kuwait.
