LETTER DATED 27 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF KUWAIT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I should like to call your attention to the increasingly inhuman practices of the Iraqi occupation forces in Kuwait. These forces have recently proceeded to empty hospitals of Kuwaiti patients, to evict them and to use these vital facilities not only for their own elements but also for those patients that they have brought from Iraq.

Another example of the savage acts being perpetrated by these forces is their indiscriminate shooting of those seeking to leave Kuwaiti territory, including those who halt at the checkpoints set up by the lraqi occupation authorities.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
