Letter dated 22 August 1990 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Ethiopia addressed to the Secretary-General

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, and with reference to the latter's note dated 8 August 1990, whereby information has been requested on the measures taken by the Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia in accordance with the provisions of Security Council resolution 661 (1990) of 6 August 1990, has the honour to communicate the following.

The Ministry wishes to assure the Secretary-General that the Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia is fully aware of its obligations under the Charter of the United Nations with regard to the resolution. Accordingly, the Office of the Council of Ministers of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has issued legally binding instructions to concerned ministries, agencies and other institutions of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to implement fully and strictly the provisions of Security Council resolution 661 (1990) of 6 August 1990.

Moreover, a mechanism for monitoring the implementation of the above-mentioned Security Council resolution has been established by the Office of the Council of Ministers of the People's Democratic Republic of Ethiopia.
