NOTE VERBALE DATED 22 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF  
ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Antigua and Barbuda to the United Nations acknowledges receipt of the Secretary-General's communication SPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990, referring to resolution 661 (1990) entitled "The situation between Iraq and Kuwait", which was adopted by the Security Council on 6 August 1990.

Acting upon the instruction of the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Antigua and Barbuda, the Honourable Lester B. Bird, the Permanent Mission of Antigua and Barbuda has the honour to inform the Secretary-General of the United Nations that the nation of Antigua and Barbuda:

- (a) Does not export or import any commodities or products to and from Iraq and Kuwait;
- (b) Does not serve as a transit State for commodities or products destined for Iraq and Kuwait or originating therefrom;
- (c) Does not hold any deposits of Iraqi or Kuwaiti origin;
- (d) Intends to abide fully with the provisions of Security Council resolution 661 (1990).
