LETTER DATED 15 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF NORWAY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instruction from my Government I have the honour to request you to convene an immediate meeting of the Security Council to consider the situation between Iraq and Kuwait, keeping in mind the grave violations of International Law and the Vienna Conventions on Diplomatic and Consular Relations perpetrated when Iraqi forces broke into the Embassies of France, the Netherlands and other countries in Kuwait, abducting foreign nationals and diplomatic personnel.
