LETTER DATED 15 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to request you to convene an immediate meeting of the Security Council to consider the situation between Iraq and Kuwait following the grave violations of international law and the Vienna Conventions on diplomatic and consular relations perpetrated by Iraqi forces against the Embassies of France, the Netherlands and other countries in Kuwait, including the abduction of foreign nationals and diplomatic personnel.

It should also be noted that violations perpetrated by the Iraqi armed forces against the Greek Embassy in Kuwait, such as cutting off of electricity and the supply of water as of 25 August 1990, forced its staff to evacuate it on 11 September 1990.
