Cuba: draft resolution

The Security Council,

Reaffirming its faith in fundamental human rights, in the dignity and worth of the human person, in the equal rights of men and women and of nations large and small,

Recalling its resolutions 660 (1990), 661 (1990), 662 (1990) and 664 (1990),

Recalling further subparagraph C of paragraph 3, and paragraph 4 of resolution 661 (1990), and deeply concerned about the safety and well being of the civilian population and of the foreign residents in Iraq and Kuwait,

Acting under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter,

1. Reaffirms that foodstuffs, medicines and medical assistance are excluded for humanitarian reasons from the sanctions established by resolution 661 (1990);
2. Declares that the provisions of resolution 661 (1990) exclude any action that hinders the supply of foodstuffs, medicines and medical assistance to the civilian population and to the foreign residents in Iraq and Kuwait and that under no circumstances shall actions of the Council cause such hindrance;
3. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Council informed about the implementation of this resolution.
