NOTE VERBALE DATED 10 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF GRENADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Grenada to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour, on instructions from his Government and with reference to the Secretary-General's note SCPC/7/90(1-2) of 8 August 1990 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990), adopted on 6 August 1990, to convey to the Secretary-General the following response from the Government of Grenada:

"The Government of Grenada supports Security Council resolution 661 (1990) in principle. The Government of Grenada wishes to indicate that, currently, there are no established trade links between Grenada and Iraq or Kuwait. However, in order to ensure that the provisions of United Nations Security Council resolution 661 (1990) are tangibly supported, the Government of Grenada has under consideration measures that would prohibit any future trade between Grenada and Iraq and Kuwait until the situation is resolved."
