NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THAILAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Thailand to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office of the Secretary-General or the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's note No. SCPC/7/90(1) dated 8 August 1990 and the former's note dated 24 August 1990 (S/21648) concerning measures to be taken by the Royal Thai Government in compliance with Security Council resolution 661 (1990), has the honour to further inform the latter that on 31 August 1990 the Thai Cabinet instructed the Ministry of Commerce to issue necessary regulations banning the import and export of goods to and from both Iraq and Kuwait. The Thai Cabinet also decided to set up a Working Group to study and to outline measures to implement other aspects of sanctions against Iraq in compliance with resolution 661 (1990) of the Security Council.
