## APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS

Appointment of three members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee
Rapporteur: Mr. Ali Ben-Said KHAMIS (Algeria)

1. At its 72nd meeting, on 6 December 1979, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General ( $\mathrm{A} / 34 / 265$ ) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal which will occur as a result of expiration of the terms of office of three members on 31 December 1979.
2. The Fifth Committee had before it two notes by the Secretary-General containing the names of four persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the United Nations Administrative Tribunal (A/C.5/34/67 and Add.1).
3. The Fifth Committee voted in two secret ballots to decide on its recommendation to the General Assembly. The result of the voting on the first ballot was as follows:

4. Mrs. Paul Bastid (France) and Mr. Mutuale Tshikankie (Zaire), having received the required majority, were declared recommended for appointment as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office commencing on 1 January 1980.
5. Since two of the candidates had received the same number of votes, it was necessary to hold a second vote to determine the third candidate to be recommended for appointment.
