Note verbale dated 22 August 1990 from the Minister for Foreign
Affairs of the Dominican Republic addressed to the
Secretary-General

The Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Dominican Republic presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and acknowledges receipt of his note SCPC/7/9(1) of 8 August 1990, in which the Secretary-General drew attention to paragraphs 6, 7 and 10 of resolution 661 (1990), adopted by the Security Council at its 2933rd meeting on 6 August 1990, concerning "The situation between Iraq and Kuwait" and requested information from the Government of the Dominican Republic on that subject.

The Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Dominican Republic informs the Secretary-General that the Government of the Dominican Republic, which upholds the principles of non-interference in the internal affairs of other States and non-recognition of acquisitions resulting from the use of force as basic tenets of its foreign policy, supports the provisions of the resolution and favours any measures that may be adopted to re-establish peace in that region in turmoil.
