1. The Federal Republic of Germany is taking into account the special needs of island developing countries by providing a particular kind of assistance, as will be seen from the table. In this context, the extensive measures in the sector of communication and traffic systems should be mentioned in particular. Furthermore, the Federal Republic of Germany has contributed substantially, within a multilateral framework, to projects in favour of island countries.
