LETTER DATED 18 SEPTEMBER 1985 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF ANGOLA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF  
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon the instructions of my Government, I have the honour to draw your attention to the most recent violent acts of armed aggression committed against the people and territory of the People's Republic of Angola by the racist régime in South Africa; the racist Armed Forces of the apartheid régime, once again crossed the sovereign border of the People's Republic of Angola on 16 September 1985 and engaged in acts of wanton destruction and brutality against Angola.

This military adventurism and expansionism of racist South Africa under the pretext of non-existent "pre-emptive strikes" of Namibian nationals, is obviously designed to draw international attention away from the conflagration that is engulfing the racist apartheid minority régime in Pretoria.

The entire world has at last finally recognized the evils of apartheid and its effects not only on the inhabitants and disenfranchised nationals of South Africa, but on the southern Africans as a whole.

South African state terrorism against its sovereign neighbours is but the external manifestation of its internal state terrorism against its majority inhabitants. Such deviousness can no longer fool the international community.

My Government wishes to bring this heinous apartheid strategy to the special attention of those who are late but welcome supporters of the national and international struggle against apartheid.

My Government also wishes to focus international attention, in particular at the beginning of the fortieth session of the United Nations General Assembly, of the international community on the violation of international law and of Angola's sovereignty and territorial integrity by a state which has been expelled from the General Assembly.

I request Your Excellency to circulate this communication as a document of the Security Council under the Question of the South African aggression against the People's Republic of Angola and its illegal occupation.
