REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF
THE REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA AT THE COMMEMORATIVE MEETING OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL, TO BE HELD ON 26 SEPTEMBER 1985

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he received a telegram on 25 September 1985 from the Minister for External Affairs of India stating that Mr. Khurshed Alam Khan, Minister of State for Commerce, has been appointed representative of India at the commemorative meeting of the Security Council to celebrate the fortieth anniversary of the United Nations, to be held on 26 September 1985.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
