Addendum

- 1. In pursuance of the request addressed to the Secretary-General by the General Assembly at its 47th plenary meeting, on 26 October 1979, the Secretary-General has informed the Assembly of the actions he has taken and the information he has received with regard to the inquiry into reports concerning a nuclear explosion by South Africa.
- 2. In this connexion, the Secretary-General has submitted to the General Assembly an interim report (A/34/639), as well as the information received from the Governments of South Africa and the United States of America (A/34/674) and of New Zealand (A/34/674/Add.1).
- 3. The Secretary-General wishes to inform the General Assembly that at this stage no further information is available to him on the subject.
