Report of the Fifth Committee (Part I)

- 1. At its 2nd meeting, on 26 September 1990, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/45/101/Add.1) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that will arise as a result of the resignation of Mr. Christopher R. Thomas.
- 2. Mr. Louis A. Wiltshire (Trinidad and Tobago) was nominated by his Government to fill the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. Thomas, that is, until 31 December 1991.
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should appoint Mr. Louis A. Wiltshire (Trinidad and Tobago) as a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a term of office beginning on ______ 1990 1/ and ending on 31 December 1991.
