Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 71st meeting, on 5 December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/55) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution IV recommended by the Second Committee (A/34/635/Add.2, para.19). The recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Comments and observations made by delegations in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.71).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution IV recommended by the Second Committee in A/34/635/Add.2, paragraph 19, the Secretary-General would be authorized to enter into commitments in an amount not exceeding \$77,750 under section 14 of the programme budget for 1980-1981. These commitments would be reflected in the performance report on the programme budget for 1980-1981.
