## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 71st meeting, on 5 December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/55) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution IV recommended by the Second Committee (A/34/635/Add.2, para.19). The recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Comments and observations made by delegations in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.71).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution IV recommended by the Second Committee in A/34/635/Add.2, paragraph 19, the Secretary-General would be authorized to enter into commitments in an amount not exceeding \$77,750 under section 14 of the programme budget for 1980-1981. These commitments would be reflected in the performance report on the programme budget for 1980-1981.
