Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 77th meeting, on 11 December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/85) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A recommended by the Special Political Committee (A/34/691/Add.1, para. 16). The recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Comments and observations made by delegations in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.77).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A recommended by the Special Political Committee (A/34/691/Add.1, para. 16), an additional appropriation of \$253,700 would be required under section 23 of the programme budget for 1980-1981. Provision of \$31,700 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment) to be offset by an increase in the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment). Additionally, conference-servicing costs not exceeding \$395,300 would arise and would be considered in the context of the consolidated paper of conference-servicing costs for 1980 at a later stage.
