> IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE GRANTING OF INDEPENDENCE TO COLONIAL COUNTRIES AND PEOPLES

Letter dated 6 December 1979 from the Permanent Representative of Venezuela to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

As you are aware, Venezuela, as a founding member of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples, had the pleasure of serving on the Committee until the end of December 1974, when it withdrew from membership owing to other commitments. It was indeed a great honour and privilege for me to have had the opportunity of personally serving the Committee as its Chairman in 1971.

I now have the honour to inform you that, subject to the concurrence of the General Assembly, it is the wish of the Government of Venezuela to rejoin the membership of the Special Committee as from January 1980.

I would be grateful if you could bing the intention of the Government of Venezuela in this regard to the attention of the General Assembly.
