Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 74th meeting, on 7 December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/66) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A and B recommended by the First Committee (A/34/749, para. 8). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Comments and observations made by delegations in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.74).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A and B recommended by the First Committee (A/34/749, para. 8), an additional appropriation of \$25,000 would be required under section 2 B of the programme budget for 1980-1981. The related conference servicing costs would be considered at a later stage in the context of the consolidated paper of conference servicing costs for 1980.
