- 1. At its 74th meeting, on 7 December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/66) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A and B recommended by the First Committee (A/34/749), para. 8). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Comments and observations made by delegations in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.74).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A and B recommended by the First Committee (A/34/749, para. 8), an additional appropriation of \$25,000 would be required under section 2 B of the programme budget for 1980-1981. The related conference servicing costs would be considered at a later stage in the context of the consolidated paper of conference servicing costs for 1980.
