Bolivia*: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Reaffirming its resolution S-18/3 of 1 May 1990, containing the Declaration on International Economic Co-operation, in particular the Revitalization of Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries,

Convinced that the full and effective implementation of the commitments and policies for international development co-operation agreed upon in the Declaration would contribute to the strengthening of international economic co-operation, in particular the revitalization of economic growth and development of the developing countries,

1. Takes note of Economic and Social Council resolution 1990/54 of 24 July 1990;
2. Calls upon Governments of Member States of the United Nations and specialized agencies to take appropriate measures to ensure the full and effective implementation of the commitments and policies for international development co-operation agreed upon in the Declaration on International Economic Co-operation,

in particular the Revitalization of Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries;

3. Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session, through the Economic and Social Council, a report on the measures taken by the Governments of developed and developing countries, individually and collectively, as well as by the bodies, organs and organizations of the United Nations system, to fulfil those commitments and policies;

4. Decides to include in the agenda of its forty-sixth session an item entitled "Commitments and policies for international development co-operation agreed upon in the Declaration on International Economic Co-operation, in particular the Revitalization of the Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries".
